Carol opened the meeting at 7:00 pm. Carol asked for approval of the agenda. John made a motion to approve the agenda. All approved.

John made a motion to approve the October minutes. Richard seconded. All approved.

John updated board members on the current financial reports.

Checking: \$9,627.01 Saving: \$38,587.38

John shared that he had changed the profit/loss report to reflect more accurately checks that were written during the current month. So far water revenue is slightly higher than last year.

John shared that the water loss was at 78%. Hiland found an issue that a ball valve had burst and could have something to do with some of the water loss. A question was raised regarding the amount of water loss and whether flooding somewhere within the water district should have been witnessed. It is obvious that something has changed over the past few months from going from a regular 30% loss to 50% and now jumping up to over 70%. John will check with Hiland to get more information.

John shared that the grant paperwork had been submitted.

Board members briefly discussed the issue of authorizing Hiland to do repairs. Board will spend more time discussing the issue and prepare to make a policy during the January meeting.

The districts insurance provider, Stratten, has requested an audit on the districts property to be conducted by an outside third party. Depending on the results of the audit there is the potential that rates may increase if the value of the property is found to be higher than the current value.

There will not be a December board meeting. The January meeting will be held on January 10th as opposed to the 17th due to making sure that a quorum can be met. John will make sure that a room is secured.

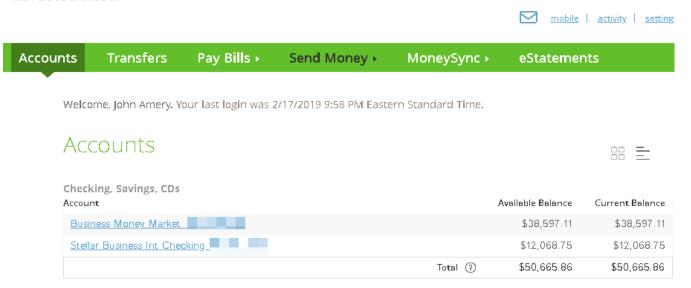
