Larry made a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Dave seconded. Motion approved. Debby made a motion to approve the February minutes. John seconded. Motion approved.

John provided the financial reports:

Checking: \$ 9,643.03 Savings: \$47,153.45

There were a number of checks that still needed to be signed. The insurance bill increased slightly. John will find out exactly what the reason is. Debby asked about the credit that used to be issued when Carl had been given credit for participating in certain trainings.

Financials are on track.

Water report indicated a lost of 29%, which was 30,510 gallons. Silas from Hiland agreed that the water loss was still high, but the amount equated to under a gallon per minute. John showed the updated GIS plot graph which is almost completed.

Board discussed the concept of a hand pump for an emergency. Matt from Hiland had concerns about possible additional engineering and larger costs and understanding that most likely Hiland would not be able to be onsite immediately. John also shared information on a smaller hand pump version as was shared by David Child's at the last meeting. Larry will do further research on the Bison hand pump.

John had asked a number of people to potentially serve on the budget committee. John made a motion for Amanda Valentine for position 5, Jeff Radford for position 3 and Susie Russ for position 1. Larry seconded the motion. Motion approved.

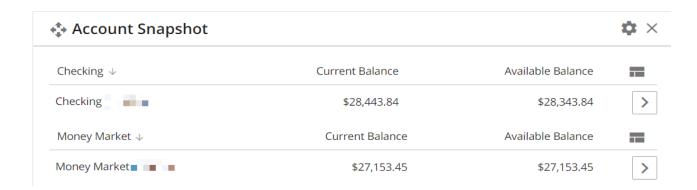
Capital Improvement projects were discussed. John recommended that we continue to focus on the hand pump and wait to see what comes at the completion of the grant work.

Item 10 - Discussion - 20% increase for insurance

Mr. Amery had a discussion with Tooley Water District insurance provider (ISU / SDIS) to better understand why our costs increased about 20% this last year.

2019: \$16182020: \$1935

It was determined that most of that cost increase was due to the increase of Tooley Water District's increased budget.

Per Tooley Water District's LB1 our budget increased from about \$46k to \$82k and our insurance costs are directly related to our LB1s.

Items that changed significantly on Tooley Water District LB1 included:

- \$20k for grant project
- \$15k for capital Improvements (up from \$5k)
- \$5k Legal

There were other minor changes that affected Tooley Water District's rate:

- Tooley Water District changed our insurance policy to reflect the appraised value rather than our
 previous estimating process. The appraisers valued Tooley structures at \$180k. Previously our
 insurance valued Tooley structures at \$101k. This change caused Tooley Water district
 property insurance portion to increase to \$352 from \$332 (\$20 increase).
- Auto insurance increased to \$175 from \$159 (\$25 increase)
