Tooley Water District June 18, 2020 Virtual Meeting

In attendance: Dave Pratt, John Amery, Larry Russ, Carol Mauser, and Debby Jones

Chairperson Carol Mauser opened the meeting at 7:26 pm

Carol asked for approval of the June meeting agenda. Carol added rate increase and Debby asked to add discussion regarding past due accounts. Dave made a motion to approve. John seconded. All approved.

Carol asked for a motion for approval of the June meeting minutes. Debby made a motion to approve the May minutes. John seconded. All approved.

John provided the financial report:

Checking \$ 8,681.07 Money Market \$47,153.45

John shared his forecasted amounts from June 2019.

The water report was shared which indicated a water loss of 9.43%. April's water loss which was 15.75%

John shared that the \$20,000 from Business Oregon had been received and deposited. This officially closes out the grant.

John updated the board on the Oregon purchasing rules as per previous board discussion regarding the process Tooley needs to follow. The projects that the board had recently been discussing were all under \$10,000. With this threshold there is not a requirement to go through a bidding process. Larry asked if the district was required to have licensed/bonded workers. Board discussed that it may depend on the scope of the project and agreed that when possible having a licensed individual/business would be best.

Larry updated board members on his research on the hand pumps. He shared that he felt that the more accurate discussion should be titled "Emergency Preparedness" and that a hand pump may be one of the discussion items. Larry talked with The Dalles Water Master. Within the next few weeks, he will come and measure the static water level. To do this the water will have to be shut off for a short period of time. Board members discussed the best way to notify members of the water shut off. Members decided to have a notification at the 2 main mailbox locations. Larry will notify when the date and time has been selected. Larry also talked with Dave Anderson with the city of The Dalles in case of an emergency water crisis. Anderson noted that the city of The Dalles has the ability to use surface water and utilize wells with back up generators. They anticipate setting up water stations. Larry also talked with Erick Grendel from North Central Public Health. Grendel spoke with a representative from the state regarding a potential hand pump. It did not appear that special permits would be required. Grendel also encouraged Larry to reach out to the Forrest Service as well as an organization called Forewarned. This organization brings other organization together to assist in times of need. The counties emergency preparedness director was also consulted, and Larry will follow-up with him per requested email. Carol volunteered to investigate potential grants.

Larry updated the board on the repair to the pump houses. A bid was presented by Valencia General Contracting, LLC for \$3,200. Larry asked an outside party if they thought the bid price is reasonable. The factors to consider would be the type of paint as well as doing more than just spraying. Valencia's bid would include spraying and back rolling. There would also need to be a considerable amount of calking. Valencia's bid also included that work with high quality calk.

Debby made a motion to approve the bid and scope of work and materials presented by Valencia

General Contracting, LLC of \$3,200. Dave seconded. John asked if the bid was confirmed or was their potential of going over. Larry could not confirm. Debby amended the motion to allow the project manager, Larry Russ, to authorize up to \$4,000 for the painting and unanticipated potential repairs to the 3 pump houses. Larry seconded. All approved.

John shared that he had reached out to Hiland regarding the replacement of the leaking flush out valve. Hiland had an estimate of \$1,800-\$2,000. Debby made a motion to allow John to oversee and authorize up to \$3,000 to replace the faulty flush out valve. Larry seconded. All approved.

Larry made the motion to authorize treasurer Amery to transfer up to \$5,000 from contingency to materials and services if required to fulfill any end of year commitments that Tooley Water District may incur until next fiscal year. Debby seconded. All approved.

Board member trainings was briefly touched on and will be tabled to next month.

John shared the Tooley Water District's Consumer Confidence Report. John has posted this report on the website. John shared that the numbers were all within the allowable limits.

John shared that there are some checks that have not been cashed and they will be reissued. It is assumed that checks have been lost.

Board briefly discussed past due accounts. John will follow up with Hiland to insure that past due policies are being followed.

Board also discussed making sure proper notification was given to members regarding the water rate increase. John will reach out to Hiland to request a notice be placed on the ongoing bills.

John shared the Hiland contract which included an addendum to the contract which included per hourly rates. John made a motion to authorize Chairperson Mauser to sign the new contract. Larry seconded. All approved.


Larry asked to have a discussion regarding the road fund since it is a part of the water bill. John will add to the July agenda.
