Tooley Water District March 18, 2021 Virtual Meeting

In attendance: John Amery, Larry Russ, Carol Mauser, and Debby Jones

Chairperson Carol Mauser opened the meeting at 7:04 pm

Carol asked for approval of the March meeting agenda. Larry made a motion to approve the agenda. John seconded. All approved.

Carol asked for a motion for approval of the February meeting minutes. John made a motion to approve the February minutes. Larry seconded. All approved.

John provided the financial report:

Checking \$ 5,653.69 Money Market \$52,178.26

John felt that revenue and expenditures were on target. One large expense for the month was the annual SDIS liability insurance charge of \$1,907.

Water report for February showed a water loss of 49.08%. There was a total of 177,680 gallons pumped but only 90,480 gallons sold. John shared charts from the sensa phone system. Further monitoring will occur.

Larry shared with the board an update regarding the district's emergency preparedness effort. The emergency contact notebook was updated, and John will review it. Larry also shared information regarding a program provided by SDAO that provides technical support for an overall review of organization policies and procedures. The review process was fairly elaborate and there is a cost associated with the review. Larry did not feel that it was the proper fit for the district. John felt that there are several free training resources that we can take advantage of and encouraged board members to take advantage of these resources as time allows. Carol shared information from the states volunteer policies that may be useful. Board discussed looking into policies that Hiland has as well as contracting with Kristen Campbell's firm as was previously discussed in past meetings. Board will revisit in April.

Board discussed the account on the vacant lot. John requested that Hiland send a letter to the address that is on file at the county. John has not heard back as of yet.

John provided the board with the need to address openings on the budget committee. Two positions will expire, Dave Childs and Susan Russ. Both individuals will be asked to continue. Carol made a motion to approve both David Childs and Susan Russ upon their acceptance. Larry seconded. All approved.

John shared with the board his work applying for a SIPP grant for a feasibility study regarding options to address the nitrate situation at the lower well. Carol asked, if the \$20,000 grant were received, where would it fit within the budget cycle, this year or next? John indicated that the new grant would fall under the next budget cycle. An RFP will need to be developed as well as contract language. Larry made the motion to authorize board members Amery and Russ to develop an RFP for a feasibility study on behalf of Tooley Water District. Carole seconded. All approved.

John made the motion to authorize chairperson Mauser to sign on behalf of Tooley Water District any required contract documents with either or both Business Oregon and the awarded RFP contractor on behalf of Tooley Water District with regards to a feasibility study. Larry seconded. All approved.

John provided a list of potential funding grants and loans.

Larry updated the board on a fuel spill near mile post 74 which is on the north end of Tooley Lake. Larry met with the hydrologist on site who was inspecting the spill. The hydrologist had a high confidence level that the district's water would not be impacted, and that the spill had been cleaned up. John received follow-up from ODOT that the site had been cleaned. John requested a copy of the report.

Larry updated the board on his conversation with the manager of the Pinewood mobile home park and the past issues with their well. Their well had been good until the farming ground across hwy 30 went from cattle to crops. A new well was drilled, and they are no longer having nitrate problems. John is waiting to hear back from the entity that is operating the farm.

John shared that there had been a FOIA request, and he was able to respond to the request in a timely manner.







Income and Expense by Month - Chart









