There is a possibility that the rate hike may have been one month late in updating which caused revenue to be slightly under projection, however new customers have come onboard and increased initial projections. Repairs and maintenance charges were discussed. Mileage charges have for Northwest water have increased. John shared that the line item for material and services was slightly over projects. This is due to new fees from Northwest Water and NWCPUD fees. These fees will have to be calculated for next year's budget. It does not appear that the refund for the Chlorinator has been received from NWW. Reports indicated that the chlorine levels have been erratic. Larry will check with NWW.

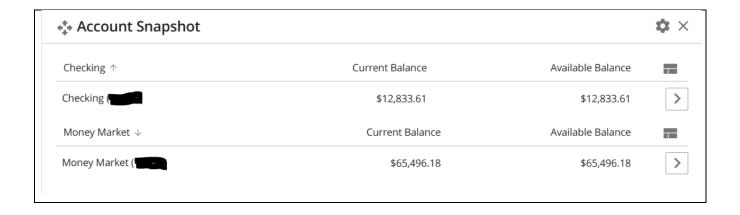

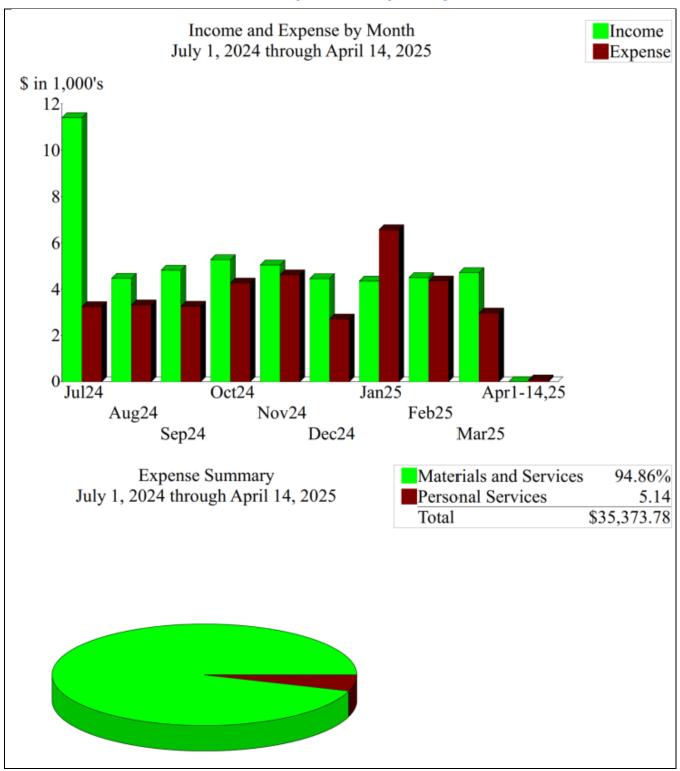

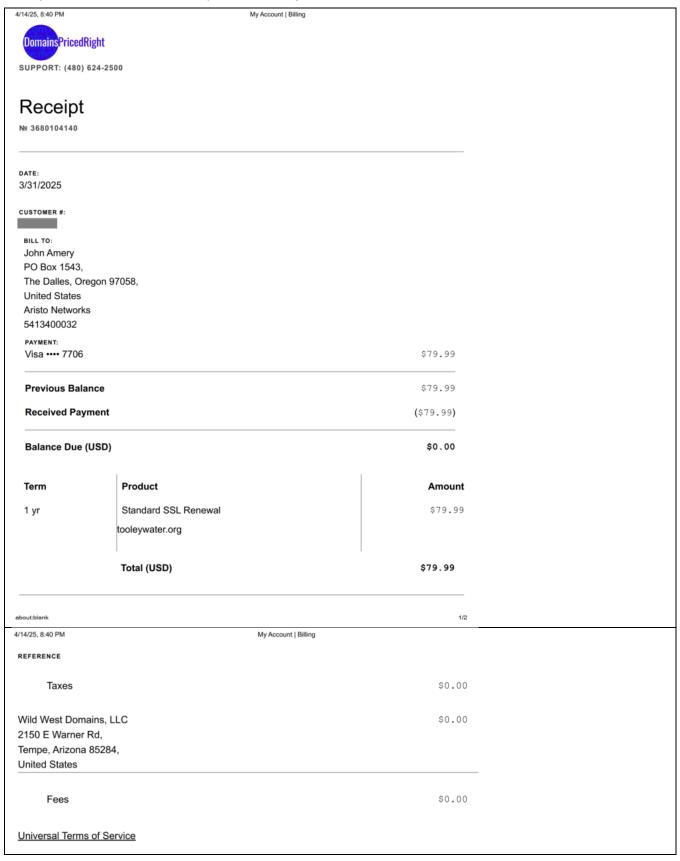
