Item 2 – Approval of Minutes

Tooley Water District May 21, 2025 Board Meeting Meeting Held Virtually 7 pm

In Attendance: John Amery, Larry Russ, Debby Jones, and Bart Vervolet Guests:

Bart offered to chair the meeting in the absence of chair Mauser

Bart opened the meeting at 7:05 PM

Item 1- Approval of Agenda: Bart asked for approval of the May agenda. John moved to approve the May agenda. Larry Seconded. Motion passed.

Item 2- Approval of Minutes: Bart asked for approval of the April minutes

John moved to accept the April minutes as presented, Larry seconded. Motion passed

Item 3 – ODHS OREM Update: John and Larry updated the board on the water delivery system. The previous MOU was no longer valid. The new IGA is different from what was previously described. Previously there was not a cap on the amount of water. There is now a cap and in the past Tooley Water District, members have surpassed those cap amounts. These amounts may have been higher due to initial deposits on the bottles. Larry felt that guidelines are needed that may include a cap on the amount of water a household has delivered. In addition, there may be an option to increase the cap on the total dollar amount of water allocated. There may be a need to request legal support on the issue. Larry's main concern is to ensure customers have clean drinking water. The board agreed that water delivery should be only when the second well is turned on and not during the time where the offending well is not in use. Members were in favor of holding an additional board member in 2 weeks, June 4.

Larry made a motion to authorize John to further negotiate the terms with ODHS OREM and sign documents as necessary. Bart Seconded. Motion passed

Item 4 – Financial Reports

Checking account Balance \$18,677.16 Money Market Balance \$65,496.18

John provided the financial reports. Revenue is higher than this same time last year. Expenses are on track.

Item 5 - Water Report: 44.36% Board members expressed concerns on the fact that there was almost half as much water lost as was sold. The discussion of having individual lines pressurized to test for leaks by Northwest Water. Larry offered to call and ask about the zero readings on the meters.

Item 6 – Discussion Nitrate Resolution Plan:

Bart is still waiting for a call back from the Gorge Commission

- John shared a brief update regarding the previously sent email on the engineering estimates.
 The initial thoughts is that the amount most likely is higher than what the financial abilities of
 Tooley Water District customers. Funds would need to be found for both a feasibility study as
 well as engineering. Board also discussed the option of a treatment plant as opposed to a
 new well.
- Item 7 Discussion/Action General System Updates: John shared data regarding the chlorine rates. Documentation showed a huge spike during April. It was unclear how this occurred.
- Item 8 Delinquent Accounts: Accounts up to date, however, there were questions regarding the number of credit adjustments to several accounts

Item 9 – NWCPUD Contract: No updates

Item 10 – NWNWS Contract – John provided updates on the current contract, specifically regarding terms if the contract needed to be terminated by either party.

Item 11 Tooley Road Association: Debby reached out to twice and has not heard back from Devin at Northwest Water. She will follow-up to ensure that Devin is still the correct person

Item 10 – New Business: Discussion occurred regarding when to turn the lower well on. John will talk with Northwest water and have it match up with their normal schedule.

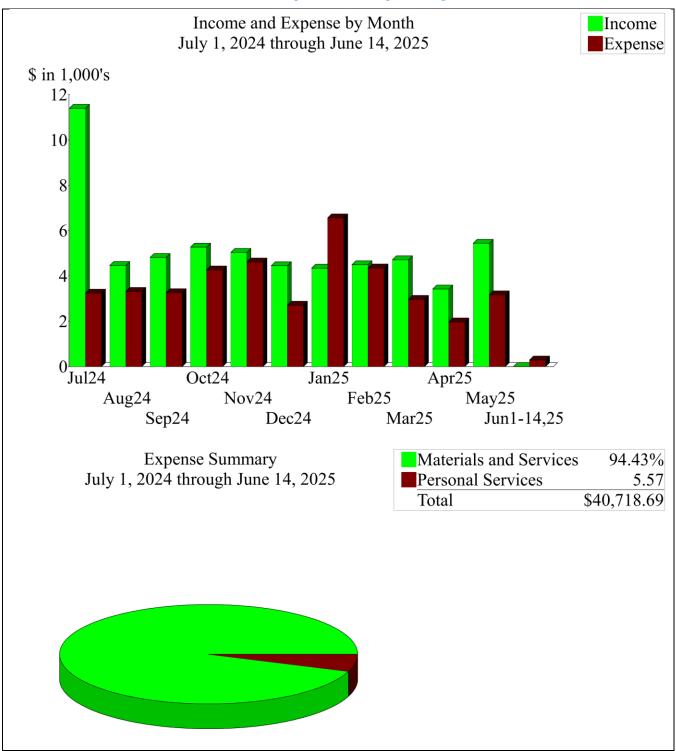
